Taxi Decal & ID Process

In accordance with Airport Rules and Regulations, the Airport will begin issuing identification badges to all taxi operators. This process is required of all cabs in order to obtain an Airport Taxi Decal (renewed annually) and operate on demand taxi service from the Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport.

Any operator who does not comply with the decal and ID procedures will NOT be allowed to operate on demand taxi service from the Airport.

STEP 1

Complete the Taxi Badge Application Packet which includes the following:

- 1. Taxi Identification Badge Permit Application
- 2. Procedures and Responsibilities Agreement
- 3. Sensitive Security Information Privacy Act Notice
- 4. Taxi Decal Application
- 5. Taxi Line/Company Responsibility Form
- 6. Line Letter (if applicable)

STEP 2

Upon completion, bring the following to the Ground Transportation Department (1st Floor Office):

- Completed application packet
- Two (2) forms of government issued identification (acceptable forms listed below)
- Current valid taxi driver permit issued by your jurisdiction
- \$45 Money Order (ONLY) made payable to "New Orleans Aviation Board"

STEP 3

Upon completion of necessary security checks, **driver will be notified** to report to Airport Security for photo.

STEP 4

Upon notification, driver will report to the Ground Transportation Department (1st Floor Office) to purchase a Taxi Decal. A \$200.00 Money Order **(ONLY)** made payable to "New Orleans Aviation Board" will be due at this time to cover the cost of the decal.

STEP 5

Airport ID will be issued to drivers when they are issued their airport taxi decal.

Renewal & Lost / Stolen Badge Fees

ID Badges will renew annually in June. The renewal fee will be \$10.00. If the driver's badge is lost or stolen the fee is \$100.00, and the driver needs a Lost / Stolen form. This form must be completed and signed by the Ground Transportation Manager before reissuing a new badge.

Fees - Money Order payable to New Orleans Aviation Board
