



Armstrong International Opens Cell Phone Lot In Time for Holiday Travel

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE --- November 17, 2006 --- On Tuesday, November 21, the Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport will open a cell phone lot in time for the Holiday Travel season.

Armstrong International Airport will open a Cell Phone Lot just in time to ease the holiday traffic congestion on the Airport roadway system.

The Cell Phone Lot, with capacity for up to 350 vehicles, provides a waiting area where motorists can park for free for a maximum of 1 hour, wait for a cell phone call from family or friends to announce their arrival, and then drive to the Airport Terminal curbside for passenger pick-up.

The new cell phone waiting area is located 3 minutes from the terminal on Airline Drive at the corner of Airline Drive and Hollandey Street across from the Airport Access Road. New fencing and improved lighting have been added to the lot and security patrols will be present.

The lot will be open from 10 am until 10 pm daily, the busiest times of the day for arriving passengers. Drivers must remain in their vehicles at all times and any unattended vehicles will be towed. "For Hire" vehicles are prohibited from using the lot.

Interim Director of Aviation Sean Hunter stated, "The Cell Phone Lot not only provides a convenient place for waiting for arriving flights, but it also helps reduces the congestion on the Airport's busy roadway system. This is just one of the many improvements we plan on implementing at Armstrong International as we work to make Armstrong International music to your eyes!"
